



VILLAGE OF CARMACKS By-law 247-18

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CARMACKS IN THE YUKON TERRITORY TO REGULATE THE CONDUCT OF THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS Section 53 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 154 of the Statutes of the Yukon (2002) and amendments thereto, provides that the Council may by Bylaw regulate the conduct of an election;

WHEREAS Section 60 (1) (a) of the Municipal Act, RSY 2002, c. 154, and amendments thereto, provides that Council may by bylaw dispense with the requirement of a list of electors for an election; and

WHEREAS Section 61 (1) (b) of the Municipal Act, RSY 2002, c. 154, and amendments thereto, provides that Council may by bylaw provide for a system of registration of persons entitled to vote at an election which shall include the prescribed oath required to be signed by each person applying to vote.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act of the Yukon Territory, the Council of the Village of Carmacks, in an open meeting duly assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Municipal Election Bylaw".

INTERPRETATION

2. In this bylaw,
 - (1) "Clerk" means the Designated Municipal Officer of the Village of Carmacks.
 - (2) "Council" means the Council of the Village of Carmacks.
 - (3) "Elector" means a person qualified to vote in a municipal election pursuant to the Municipal Act.
 - (4) "Village" means the Village of Carmacks.

ELECTION OFFICIALS

3.
 - (1) Bonnie Cooper is hereby appointed Returning Officer.
 - (2) The Returning Officer appointed by Council hereby has delegated authority to appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks as necessary.
 - (3) Election officials shall, during their employment, refrain from any active or public support or criticism of any candidate.

NOMINATIONS

4.
 - (1) Council Chambers located in the Village office is hereby designated as the place for nomination proceedings.
 - (2) Nomination Day is September 27, 2018
 - (3) Nominations will be received by the Returning Officer no later than 12 o'clock noon on Thursday, September 27, 2018.

PLACES AND HOURS OF POLLS

5.
 - (1) The advance polling place and the regular polling place shall be established in the Council Chambers in the Village Office.
 - (2) The advance poll shall be held Thursday, October 11, 2018, and the hours of the poll shall be from 8:00am to 8:00pm.
 - (3) The regular poll shall be held Thursday, October 18, 2018, and the hours of the poll shall be from 8:00am to 8:00pm.

FEES

6. The following rates shall be paid to persons acting as election officials, other than full time officers or employees of the Village of Carmacks.

REPEAL

7. Bylaw #221-15 is hereby repealed.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 7th DAY of August, 2018.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 21st DAY of August, 2018.
